Sing the song at least once a day. It can be at the beginning, middle or end of a lesson. Our recommendation is to start the first lesson of the day with this song, but it can be incorporated at any time. It may be a good movement activity if the students are getting restless and having a hard time paying attention. Sing the song with the students and do the motions to encourage participation.
