Challenge your child to help you build a face out of food that includes as many different plant parts as possible. Examples of some foods that come from different plant parts are below. SeedS: corn, beans, nuts

roots: carrots, radishes, sweet potatoes

stems: celery, asparagus leaves: spinach, lettuce

flowers: broccoli, cauliflower

fruit: oranges, apples, tomatoes, bell peppers

- Compliment your child's ideas and creativity as he or she creates a face.
- · Let your child see you eating and enjoying the different plant parts.
- Let your child hear you describing the food you are enjoying together.
 (Such as: "The lettuce is crispy," or "I love the juicy orange," or "I think this bell pepper is sweet!")
