- Different shades of same color
- Are smooth, comfortable on the eyes



## Analogous Colors

- Side-by-side on the color wheel
- Are considered to be relaxing color groups



## Complimentary Colors

- Opposite of each other on the color wheel
- Are balanced, complementing color groups
