GET THE DETAILS!

Who: Any certified, active K-12 teacher (all subject areas) teaching in a public school or K-12 teacher (all subject areas) teaching in an accredited non-public elementary and secondary educational institution, as well as Education Service Center or other district educators.

What:

A four-day professional development opportunity that immerses teachers in multiple aspects of agriculture to increase agricultural literacy in the classroom. SAI incorporates presentations by agricultural experts who specialize in education. The four-day institute also includes site visits to area farms, ranches, and agricultural businesses for a truly hands-on experience.

SAI 2023 will include site visits to:

- An AgriLife Extension beef research location
- A hydroponics farm
- A honey farm
- The Livestock Nutrition Center

Educators will also learn from Texas Ag in the Classroom and National Ag in the Classroom staff, AgriLife Extension specialists, and so many others.
